- Entrants must be prepared to co-operate fully with the Trust in response to enquiries for further information. Entrants may be required to make a presentation to the judges.
- The decision of the judges is final and the Trust will not enter into further correspondence.
- Entrants must be prepared to co-operate with the Trust in activities to publicise the entry.

What we are looking for

- Real evidence of how the work of the person nominated has furthered equality in employment in the UK, whether through statistical progress with the organisation(s), 'leading edge' innovations, establishing an important legal precedent, achieving equality gains for workers etc.
- Convincing evidence of the nominated person's key role in the achievements.
- The extent of the individual's effort, tenacity, commitment etc to the achievement, taking into account factors such as the resources available, the length of time involved and the obstacles and resistance which needed to be overcome.
- Achievements which have been seen in furthering equality at work in the last three years.
- That the achievements have been over and above the call of duty where they fall within the nominated person's normal job responsibilities.

Judging process

- Judges will be drawn from Wainwright Trust trustees or their nominees.
